This is the second and heaviest chapter of your child's Class 12 Applied Mathematics book. A 'matrix' is simply a grid of numbers arranged in rows and columns — a neat way to organise data, like a price table or a sales sheet. This chapter teaches the rules for adding, scaling, and multiplying these grids, then introduces the 'determinant' (a single number that summarises a square grid) and the 'inverse' (the matrix equivalent of dividing). The grand payoff is a reliable, step-by-step machine for solving several equations at once — the kind that appears when you work out the prices of several commodities from their combined costs. It is more computation than reasoning: careful, tidy arithmetic is rewarded with full marks.

5 QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD

- What does the 'order' of a matrix mean, and when can two matrices be multiplied together?
- Why is AB not always equal to BA for matrices?
- How do you know whether a matrix has an inverse or not?
- What is the difference between a symmetric and a skew-symmetric matrix?
- Can you solve two equations like $2x + 3y = 13$ and $x + y = 5$ using the matrix method?

WEAK-SPOT INDICATORS

- If your child cannot recall that the inverse exists only when the determinant is non-zero, the core idea of the chapter is missing.
- If they forget the alternating $+ - +$ sign pattern when expanding a 3×3 determinant, almost every determinant and inverse answer will be wrong.
- If they treat matrix multiplication like ordinary number multiplication (assuming $AB = BA$), they will lose marks on every multiplication question.

WHEN TO WORRY — AND WHAT TO DO

If, after attempting one question each on multiplication, determinant, inverse, and solving a system, your child gets fewer than three correct, schedule one focused 90-minute drill session. This chapter is almost pure procedure — neat, repeated practice fixes it faster than any other chapter in the book.
