Management of Sporting Events

POSDC = Planning · Organising · Staffing · Directing · Controlling (in this order)

BYES = (next higher power of 2) – N teams

When byes are odd, EXTRA bye goes to LOWER half

KNOCK-OUT total matches = $N - 1$

LEAGUE total matches = $N(N-1)/2$

SEEDING = strongest teams in opposite halves so they meet only in final

INTRAMURAL = WITHIN institution (intra = within)

EXTRAMURAL = OUTSIDE institution (extra = beyond)

COMMITTEES (pre / during / post) = arrangement, finance, publicity, refreshment, transport, first-aid, prize, etc.

COMMUNITY SPORTS

PROGRAMMES = Sports Day · Health Run · Run for Fun · Run for Specific Cause · Run for Unity

TOP 5 PYQ PATTERNS**1 POSDC five functions**

5 marks · 95% of years

Name in order · 1 sentence definition + 1 example per function · don't forget Controlling.

2 Knock-out fixture for N teams

5 marks · 90% of years

Total = $N-1$ matches · byes = $\text{power}2 - N$ · upper/lower halves · diagram clearly labelled.

3 Intramural vs Extramural

3 marks · 85% of years

Definition · example · 3 contrasts (scope/purpose/resources).

4 Committees responsibilities

4 marks · 80% of years

Pre-event (planning) · during-event (execution) · post-event (review).

5 League matches calculation

2 marks · 80% of years

Formula $N(N-1)/2$ · substitute · show arithmetic.
